WE NEED CANDY – LOTS OF CANDY!!!

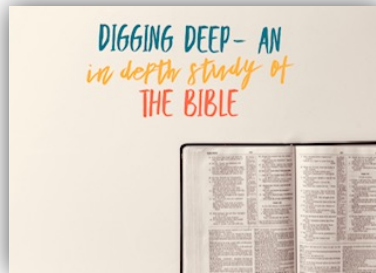
We are putting together candy treat bags for our teachers since this six weeks ends on October 30th.
