When we gather on **June 14th** for our first in-person worship since Covid-19 caused us to move online, we will have the following guidelines in place:

- 1. If you are uncomfortable gathering, or have an underlying condition, please feel free to stay home and worship through our online resources (Zoom and Facebook).**
- 2. Masks are strongly encouraged.**
- 3. We will have assigned seating for the time being. Most everyone will be in their normal area. A few will be scattered to other areas because of spacing. This will take care of everyone trying to figure our proper spacing/seating, etc.**
- 4. We will have one door for entering (under the bell tower). It will open at 10:45am. Please refrain from coming early.**
- 5. We will have one door for exit (the middle doors between the sanctuary and the office).**
- 6. All communion supplies and bulletins will be placed in the pews/racks before worship.**
- 7. We will have an offering plate set up as you leave for you to give your tithe or offering. Please do not handle the plates.**
- 8. We will not be singing for the first few weeks as continue to assess its safety given our facility layout and design.**
- 9. We will not have a greeting time and encourage everyone to use appropriate social distancing before, during and after worship. No hugs, handshakes, etc.**
- 10. The building will be sanitized before and after worship each week.**

This will be in place of our Sunday morning Sunday School time while we are transitioning back to in-person gatherings.

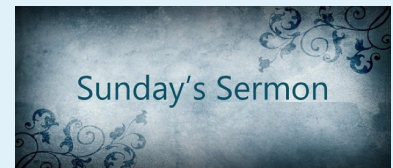
